This Week: We learned all about the city, countries and neighborhoods and the differences in each setting. We also had a great time talking about the tools different workers use for their jobs. Language Arts: We focused on the letter Nn and the sight words day and today. Please continue to practice all sight words at home. In addition, your child should be working on composing and writing their own sentences (5-7 words long) including capitalization, spacing and punctuation. Please practice this at home as part of their at-home practice. In addition, please sign your child up for our SIGHTS app (information was sent on Bloomz). This is a great way for your child to practice sight words. I will check a few time a week to raise your child to the next level.

Math: One of our math standards which we will be assessing is composing and decomposing numbers 0-10. (better know as adding and subtracting). Please practice this at home on a white board by giving your child basic equations to work out. It might help them to have items to count when working out the equations. (2+5= 7+3= 9-2= 4-3=)
