This Week: We finished up our two-week study as zoologists. We studied information about the orangutan, kangaroo, flamingo, tiger and red panda. We learned where they live on the globe, their prey or predators, if they are carnivores, herbivores or omnivores and if they are safe or endangered. We talked about WHY they are endangered and what WE can do to help them. We also learned how to identify a primate, a marsupial and A-pex predators. Ask your child to tell you what they know about A-pex predators and what creature feature we, as humans, have that make us A-pex. (answer: our brain)

Our field trip to the Sacramento Zoo is on Monday, May 14th.

Character Development: We will be awarding our two kiddos who have shown perseverance this last month as we have completed our computer testing.

Language Arts: Please have your child practice composing and writing sentences independently. As part of our assessment we will be looking at how many sentences they can write independently. We will also be assessing the kids on reading 80 sight words and 20 sound out words. To find all the sight words look to the left at the list and add number and color words.

Math: We will be assessing the kids on identifying three dimensional shapes, adding and subtracting basic equations, identifying the tens and one place in any given number and counting to 100. This information will be used on our report cards.

Field trip on Monday: We will be visiting the Sacramento Zoo on Monday. Please have your child wear their Lighthouse T-shirt, comfortable shoes and a hat. Don't forget the sunscreen as we will be outside for a few hours. We will be taking our lunches and have a picnic across the street at McKinley park. Please pack a water bottle and a snack for your child. We should return to school by 1:30.
